### **COVID-19 Restrictions Lifting March 14, 2022**

Public Health will lift COVID-19 restrictions effective March 14, 2022, provided conditions remain favourable.

Please note the *COVID-19 Vaccine Regulations* are separate from Special Measures and remain in effect until at least June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. This means students may be asked to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination when taking part in work terms, field placements, on-the-job-training, clinical placements, practicums, etc. Staff members, service providers, clients and guests are required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination in order to enter College buildings. Academy Canada encourages anyone who is eligible to get vaccinated.

Academy Canada will return to primarily in-person programming effective March 14<sup>th</sup>. If you are currently off-site, please check your Academy Canada email account for information about returning to the campus. If you have concerns about returning to in-person instruction, please reach out to Senior Campus Administration to discuss possible accommodations.

Please note, masks are still required in the Massage Therapy Clinic. Academy Canada supports staff members who wish to continue using Plexiglas barriers and who request people to wear masks in their offices and classrooms.

In order to stay healthy, it is important to continue practicing good hygiene, such as washing or sanitizing your hands on a regular basis. Cleaning supplies will continue to be available should you wish to clean your working area before and after use.

If you have symptoms, please stay home until you are well and notify your instructor of your absence. Isolation requirements are still in place for COVID-19, as per public health direction. Instructors will continue to use World Classroom so you may be able to continue learning from home in order to minimize disruption to your learning plan.
