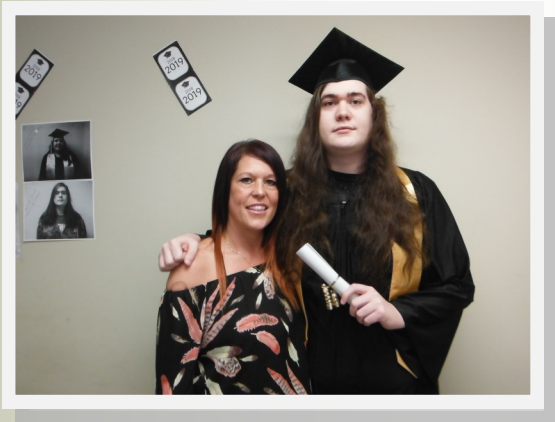
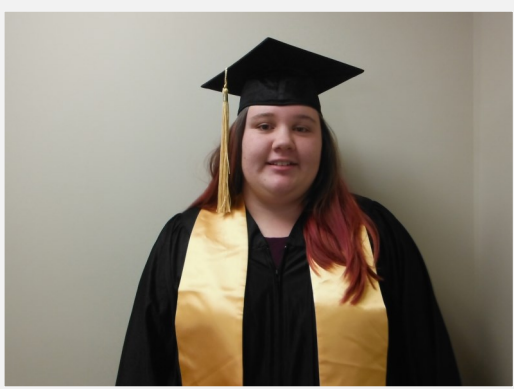


Labrador West

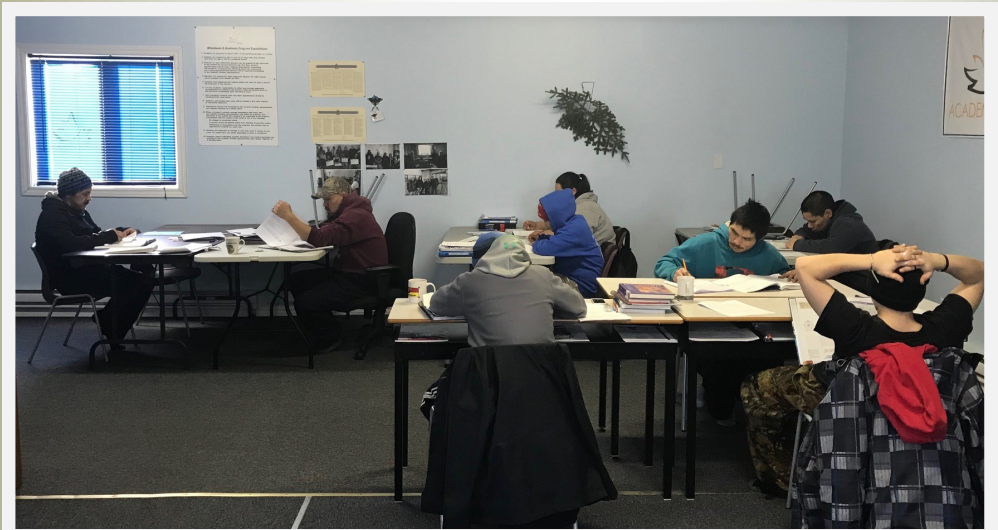
Many thanks to former Instructor, Nick Peddle, for his hard work and organization during his three-month stay. We all wish him well in his future endeavours.

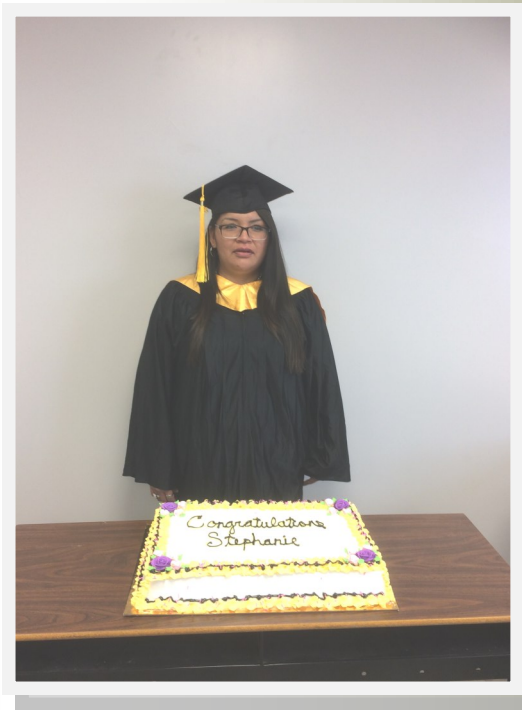
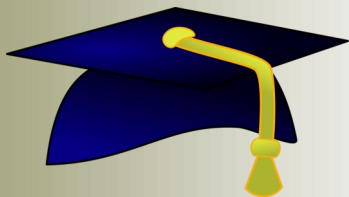

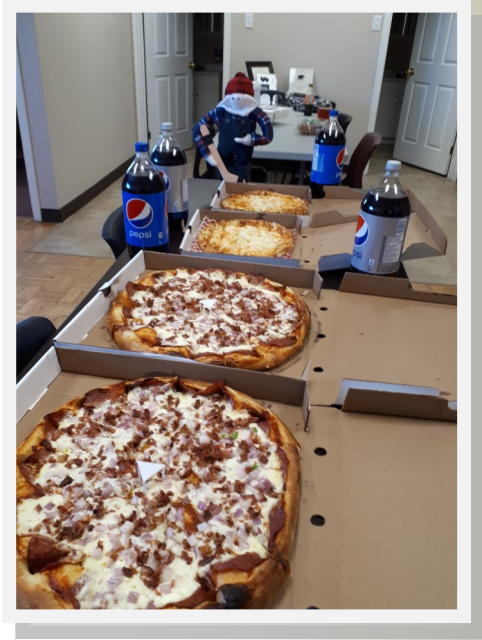
CBS
