Safety Boots Gloves **Goggles/Safety Glasses** Hard Hat (CSA Approved - Side Impact) Adjustable Wrenches - 6" and 8" 1 of each **Combination Wire Stripper** Electrician's Knife Flashlight Gyproc Saw Hack Saw Hammers – Claw and Ball Peen Level – Torpedo (Magnetic) Measuring Tape Multimeter CAT-III

Pliers: Diagonal Side-Cutting Lineman's Side-Cutting Needle Nose Pump (slip joint) 8" or 9" pliers 1 of each Portable Tool Box/Bag/Pouch Screwdrivers: Robertson #1, #2 and #3, Phillips #1 and #2, Standard (3 sizes) 1 of each Stud Finder

- 1. It is recommended that you not purchase tools/supplies until after you meet with your instructors. This also applies to purchasing used textbooks.
- 2. Further purchases may be required. Please verify with your instructor.
- 3. Most of the items listed above can be purchased from Guillevin International, Rideout Tool and Machine or Acklands-Grainger.
