



Materials List and Safety Dress Code: Hairstylist (Entry)

The profession of Hairstyling is a continually growing personal service industry in North America today. It is a highly personal service and an exciting, rewarding career because of the variety of services given to clients during a typical day. Academy Canada is committed to training you in a learning environment that is supportive of the needs of the whole student and academically sound in content and delivery. Academy Canada promises to maintain an atmosphere that is safe, professional and emulates the Hairstylist workplace, and we expect the same from our students. In order to achieve this, we see it as important that our Hairstylist students dress in a safe, professional and suitable manner. Please note the required dress code for the Hairstylist program:

- ❖ Scrubs - Matching top and pants. Please avoid pale colors. Students may wear a suitable light weight T-shirt or long-sleeved T-shirt under the scrub top.
- ❖ Closed-in sneakers or running shoes (slip resistant), worn with socks of some sort to protect exposed feet and ankles.

OR

- ❖ Dress pants or skirt (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) with a professional top (discrete, with sleeves)
- ❖ Leggings must be worn with a long top (no shorter than 3-4 inches above the knee)
- ❖ Shoes should not have a heel higher than 2 inches, with a wedged or sturdy heel with support (no spiky heels)
- ❖ Students must also have a lab jacket or apron to protect their clothing
- ❖ Jeans and tank tops are not permitted

Students are required to purchase the following materials. NB: The number of items suggested represents the required minimum.
